The *Erika Hall Memorial Fund*, along with its sister funds noted below, was established by family and friends in 2014 through the Community Foundation of Southeastern Mass (CFSEMA) to honor the memory of their late daughter, granddaughter, sister, and friend Erika Hall. Erika was a unique beacon of light and life to all who knew her, and her powerful influence remains active among us all to this day. All of these funds seek to provide assistance in the living out of life beyond high school, in the many various ways that suit our own personalities, as Erika would have encouraged us to. The criteria for election of recipients will be broad (see below). As such, these are neither GPA nor need based scholarships, per se, so feel free to submit an application!

Along with the more traditional *scholarships*, and as fund-raising efforts allow, *Erika Hall Memorial Grants and Awards* will be made available to recent graduates of WHS in particular, though not exclusively, to those whose high school years would have overlapped with Erika's. (Westport kids from Diman, Connolly, Aggie and Stang may also apply. See specific scholarship/grant/award instructions for full list of qualified applicants) These grants and awards are for the pursuing of whatever *other* things life brings your way (research projects, studio work, humanitarian projects, knowledge via travel and cultural immersion, artistic endeavors, musical forays...any idea is fair game if it can be considered to have "growth and educational potential".) Submit a request for these life enrichment grants and we will let you know if and when funds become available.

About Erika Hall

Erika Hall was a sophomore at WHS who died in a car accident while out with friends late April 2014. Erika was involved and interested in many things (dance, music, art, field hockey, track, international exchange, beach life, a top student at school, employed at several area locations, etc.) yet it was not so much her activities that made her a standout but her relationships. Friends. Family. Employers. Teachers. Parents. Coaches. The 2-year-olds in her Saturday morning dance class. The young ladies she babysat. International teens here for a glimpse of life in the USA.

Erika had a way of putting a smile on your face and making you feel welcome. Whole. Loved. Her zest for life was contagious and insatiable, and she definitely wanted us all to be a part of it. It is for these reasons, and many more, that the family and friends of Erika Hall strove to create these scholarships and grants to further that sense of adventure in fellow students and to give back to a community and student body that had given so much to them during those trying days.

Erika Hall Memorial Grants and Awards Info for ALL applicants

-Category 1 - Available for graduates of WHS, associated GED holders, and Westport graduates of the above mentioned sister schools, original preference being given to those students in attendance during the 2013-2020 time block, as funds allow. Members of each year's graduating class may also apply in the calendar year of their graduation (ie 2016 grads can apply to either of the 2016 deadlines) to allow funding for activities directly post graduation (those happening before next deadline) and possibly activities happening even earlier in that year (ie, spring semester high school). Students who move outside the school district but spent at least 2 years at WHS may also apply.

-Category 2 – Available for high school underclassmen (9th-11th) and first semester seniors. Applicants must be Westport residents attending WHS or any of the above named sister schools.

-Funds dispersed based on availability. Only requests not exceeding \$5,000 will be considered. Funds may be dispersed pre-, mid-, or post-project, depending upon the nature and implications of the request. An agreement may be put down in writing and signed by both parties upon acceptance. CFSEMA (our fund's "mother ship", so to speak) will contact you directly if this is so. Please be alert to their emails.

-In order to consider different types of applications and projects, different fund accounts may have been established, some with tax advantages, some without. Consult your tax adviser for filing rules and implications.

-Requests falling outside the framework of a 501c(3) charitable foundation will be considered separately, *through an entirely different (and heretofore not-established) fund*, and will have no direct involvement nor association with either the WEF or CFSEMA, nor monies raised thus.

-The acceptance of some grants and awards may have a small, required, community give back or community learning piece attached to it.

-Grants and Awards considered biannually, as funds allow. As such, first round applications are **due January 31** with acceptance notifications going out by February 28. Assuming permission, facebook and website winner postings will be made by March 15. Second round applications are **due July 31** with acceptance notifications going out by August 30, permissioned web postings by September 15. Applications not funded initially will be automatically considered for the *next round of funding only*, unless we receive an email from you requesting otherwise.

-Applications (We only need pgs 3-5 (Category 1) or 3-6 (Category 2). Keep the rest for your records!) can be mailed to:
